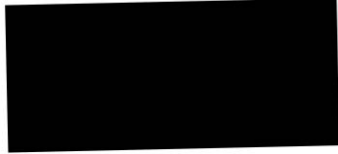

Of the person who died due to COVID19 in India and had previously other diseases, please give separately for each disease: how many persons and percentages had which diseases along with names and voter number of those persons	The chapter 2, 8.(j) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, mentions there is no obligation to give any citizen the information which relates to personal information the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual. Hence the required information cannot be provided.
